In this gathering, we will hear about the latest developments on the ground, how CRS is adjusting and expanding our response to meet the ever-evolving needs and get an up-close view of how global events impact individual lives. We will have time for questions and conversation with Jennifer and Erik. Their moving and insightful accounts will offer a ray of hope in the midst of this terrible crisis and paint a striking picture of how your support to CRS is making an immediate impact on the lives of families fleeing the fighting.
