### Clarification on Permitted and Non-Permitted Parish Activities

(Note: These will be updated in the next Tuesday Parish Guidance)

## PERMITTED "INDOOR" PARISH ACTIVITIES:

- Indoor Masses for Livestream Purposes Only (Special allowance, granted by the County)
  - The building must be closed to the public. (No sacraments or other liturgical celebrations allowed).
  - Participants are limited to the celebrant, lector, cantor, musicians, and person(s) directly involved with livestreaming.
  - One cantor singing alone in a separate enclosed room is allowed.
  - All must wear face coverings and maintain a minimum physical distance of six feet apart.
  - Priests are to wear a face covering when distributing Communion.
  - Must have 10 or less individuals assisting with mass.
- Indoor Parish Ministries (faith formation, vacation bible school, etc.) limited to only socially distanced parish employees/instructors, with participants participating virtually via Zoom/offsite.
  - All must wear face coverings and maintain a minimum physical distance of six feet apart.
  - Must have 10 or less employees/instructors.

#### PERMITTED "OUTDOOR" PARISH ACTIVITIES:

- Outdoor Masses, Sacramental/Liturgical Celebrations, and Religious Gatherings
  - County expanded the limit of participants to no more than 60 people max (in addition to 100 cars).
  - o All must wear face coverings and maintain a physical distance of six feet apart.
- Outdoors Parish Sacraments –Weddings, Baptisms, Funerals (60 people max)
  - o All must wear face coverings and maintain a physical distance of six feet apart.
- Outdoor Ministries parishioner meetings/faith formation/vacation bible school/CCD, etc., with participants (60 people max).
  - All must wear face coverings and maintain a physical distance of six feet apart.

#### **NON-PERMITTED "INDOOR" PARISH ACTIVITIES:**

- Indoor Mass with parishioners/public, except for the livestream Mass as indicated above.
- Indoor Parish Ministries (faith formation, vacation bible school, etc.) with parishioners/public.
- Meetings of Parishioners or any Other Groups
  - O Does not include; gatherings in school classrooms.

# **NON-PERMITTED "OUTDOOR" PARISH ACTIVITIES:**

- **No singing at Masses**, except in circumstances where the cantor is alone in a separate enclosed room or space like a vehicle.
- Leasing/Renting of indoor/outdoor Parish Facilities to Third-Party Groups (ex., Soccer, chess, volleyball clubs; Boy scouts; Knights of Columbus, receptions, etc.).
