

The \$62 million goal for Sowing Seeds of Faith represents a carefully planned investment in spiritual renewal, with every dollar strategically allocated to the six pastoral plan priorities to maximize impact across our diocese.

\$27 MILLION RETURNS TO PARISHES Empowering local communities to pursue Pastoral Plan projects tailored to their unique needs.

\$5.5 MILLION FOR SOLIDARITY FUND Supporting parishes in high-need communities, rapid growth areas, or those with limited financial resources, ensuring no community is left behind.

\$22 MILLION TO DIOCESAN-WIDE INITIATIVES Funding youth evangelization hubs, catechist certification programs, just wages for staff, seminarian training, priest retirement care, and more.

\$7 MILLION FOR ANNUAL DIOCESAN APPEAL In place of the 2026 ADA: covering annual diocesan operating expenses.
